THIS COURT ORDERS that this matter be adjourned to the 17th day of November, 2004, at 9:30 a.m. for review and for a committal hearing without the necessity of filing or serving a Summons to a Committal Hearing.

THIS COURT ORDERS that arrears of maintenance owing from Harold Arthur Jeffery to Maggie Anne St. Aubrey, under the order of the Honourable Mr. Justice Shabbits made February 22, 2001 and the Honourable Madam Justice Ballance made October 3, 2003, are fixed at FIFTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND TWENTY-THREE CENTS (\$15,555.23) as at August 11, 2004, plus interest pursuant to the *Family Maintenance Enforcement Act* plus statutory fees owing to the Director of Maintenance Enforcement.


THIS COURT ORDERS that Harold Arthur Jeffery shall pay to Maggie Anne St. Aubrey the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per month towards the arrears commencing the 1st

day of October, 2004, and a like sum on the first day of each and every month thereafter until further court order.

THIS COURT ORDERS that Harold Arthur Jeffery shall be imprisoned seven (7) days in a British Columbia Correctional Centre each time he fails to pay both the arrears payment required by this order and any regular maintenance payment due under the order made October 3, 2003 by the date specified in this order for each arrears payment upon failure to show cause why such imprisonment should not take place; with time to be served consecutively.
