In Canada, over the last decade, the federal government has been steadily working towards eliminating your rights as a parent through specific changes to the *Divorce Act*. **Martin Cauchon**, the Liberal Minister of Justice in 2002 took a major step towards the implementation of an alarming piece of legislation called **Bill C-22** which moves to eliminate your rights as a parent. At the present time **Bill C-22** primarily applies to the children of divorced parents, however, the impact of **Bill C-22** will eventually apply to all parents and all children in Canada.

Bill C-22 failed to become law only due to the timing of the recent dissolution of parliament and the departure of Jean Chretien. However, **Bill C-22** has not died. **Bill C-22** continues to enjoy

the strong support of **Irwin Cotler**, current Liberal Minister of Justice. **Bill C-22** means the government will be deciding what your children are taught, what religious upbringing they will have, what moral and ethical training they are exposed to. **Government will even decide on how often you should see your children.**

Through **Bill C-22** the government seeks to control the soul of our children. Our children and families must be protected.

People arrive in Canada from all over the world with hopes of building a better life for themselves and their families – a life with rights. Ironically, there is a real danger of losing our children

to a government with its own agenda.

It is time for Canadians to wake up to the impact of the legislation that the liberal government is trying to implement. It is time to take action by way of not voting for any government that supports the seizing of Canadian children. Canadians must work hard towards electing representatives who will rid the civil service of those who work to eliminate the rights and freedoms of the citizens of this country. We need bureaucrats who realise that **children need both parents.**
