What is the purpose of this Notice of Attachment ?

The Director of Maintenance Enforcement has served this notice of attachment to enforce a maintenance order against the **DEBTOR**.

How much maintenance will be paid ?

### TO ATTACHEE :

- You are required to deduct money from any sum you presently owe the **DEBTOR**, or which you may owe that person in the future, until the expiry of this notice on **April 26, 2012**. The deductions are :
  - To satisfy maintenance arrears of \$ **1,286.80 @ 26Feb2007**, and
  - To settle ongoing maintenance payments as they become due. These payments are in the amount of :  
\$ **318.00** which is due the 01st day of the Month.
  - To settle any interest accrued on unpaid maintenance payments after the date of this notice.
  - To satisfy default fees of \$
 Unless you are notified otherwise, you must assume that any maintenance payments which have become due between the date of this notice and the date you received it, have **not** been paid. **Add** amounts noted in paragraph 1(b) which have become due to the arrears stated in paragraph 1(a) above.

How much should I send the program ?

- To calculate the amount you must deduct, follow the instructions next to the box(es) marked below :
  - Debtor is entitled to exemptions and can claim tax deduction for maintenance. Use Formula 1 ( if an employee ) or Formula 3 ( if not an employee ) on the reverse side of this Notice.
  - Debtor is entitled to exemptions but cannot claim tax deduction for maintenance. Use Formula 2 ( if an employee ) or Formula 4 ( if not an employee ) on the reverse side of this Notice.
  - None of the money you owe the debtor is exempt from attachment. Deduct the lesser of either the amount you owe the debtor or the total amount due under paragraph 1(a), 1(b), 1(c) and 1(d).
  - For Employment Insurance, Canada Pension Plan, Old Age Security and National Training Act (Canada) payments, deduct the lesser of either 25% of the payment or the total amount due under paragraph 1(a), (b), (c) and (d).

**After other arrears are paid, check with the FMEP for the amount of interest owing under paragraph 1(c) above.**

Who do I make the cheque payable to ?  
Where do I send the payments ?

When do I send payments ?

- Payments must be sent within **5 days** after you deduct them from money due to the debtor.

What information must I send the Program ?

- You **must complete** and **return** the included Response By Attachee form **within 10 days** after you receive this notice, even if you do not owe anything to the debtor. Please keep a photocopy for your records.

What happens if I do not pay ?

- If you do not pay as set out in this notice, or if you do not return the Response form within 10 days after receiving the Notice, you may be taken to court and may be held liable for the amount you failed to pay.
